Project Overview:

The John Stokes Square housing complex in Nightcliff comprised 75 public housing units that were nearing the end of economic life. The site has been earmarked for redevelopment to improve the quality of housing, allow for improved amenities and open spaces, and reduce anti-social behaviour, and will include:

- A new 24-hour police station;
- Complex-needs public housing (targeting seniors and people living with disabilities); and
- A public space to link pedestrians between the Nightcliff Shops and the Woolworths complex.



NTEX has been awarded the \$1,079,000 demolition contract with works beginning in June 2019 and expected completion date of 5th August 2019. The project includes demolition of 75 public housing units including asbestos removal.

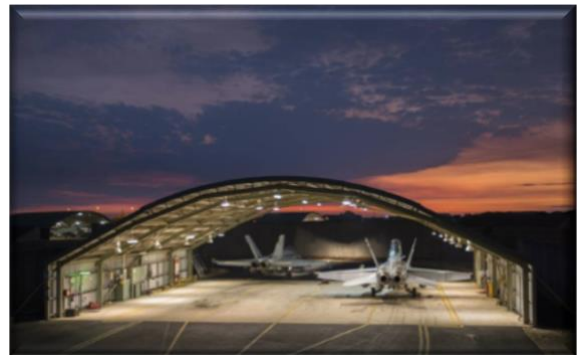
Project Overview:

RAAF Base Tindal is located 15 kms outside Katherine and 320 kms south-east of Darwin in

the Northern Territory. The airfield was originally constructed in 1942 during World War II and was originally called Carson's Airfield. Over time, it was upgraded and extended for commercial use and declared an operational Air Force Base in 1984, with an official opening on 1 October 1988.

Although it is Air Force's youngest operational base (except for bare bases), it is now one of Australia's most important defence sites.

The proposed works at RAAF Base Tindal will include an F-35A Operational Precinct, upgrades to the on-base warehouse, minor pavement upgrades, counter measure storage and preparation facilities, engineering infrastructure and replacement of displaced elements.



NTEX is established as an approved civil contractor for the Department of Defence and has been engaged to carry out the following works:

- detailed excavation of trenches for laying of electrical conduits and other civil infrastructure on site
- Development of flood retention basins
- Installation of 130,000L attenuation tanks

Project Overview:

Garramilla Boulevard is an NT Government project to provide a new entry point to Darwin's CBD. This project will also complete the duplication of Tiger Brennan Drive from Dinah Beach Road to McMinn Street. This is a landmark project that will help unlock the potential of the city's eastern end.

The new road will connect Tiger Brennan Drive directly with Cavenagh Street to more evenly distribute traffic throughout the CBD streets. The Boulevard will have a tropical, inner city urban feel and support economic development in Darwin CBD.

NTEX was engaged to carry out demolition of the Old Quarantine Building and Frog's Hollow toilet block in Darwin city as part of the Boulevard works.

Project works involved securing the site, co-ordination of asbestos removal, demolition of buildings, site clearance including grubbing up of hard standings, and transportation of waste to Shoal Bay Waste Transfer Facility.

Batchelor is a multi species abattoir located south of Darwin which was in mothballed due to problems with ownership of title deeds. The abattoir hasn't operated since 2003 and is currently undergoing major renovations. The Central Agri Group have recently taken on a lease of the plant and are undertaking a \$5 million upgrade. The company are planning to process cattle, buffalo and camels.

NTEX were engaged to undertake ancillary works for the wastewater treatment facility including:

- Cut and fill of 70,000 m3 to facilitate construction of 7 x 6 m high pond walls
- Installation of pond overflow and storm water control pipes, plumbing and concrete infrastructure
- Road construction works

This project was completed on time, to a high-quality finish and to budget with additional works requested to be undertaken.

Project Overview:

AACo's Livingstone Beef processing facility is located in the Livingstone Valley, approximately 50 kilometres south of Darwin in the Northern Territory. The facility produced export beef, hides and rendered products.

AACO commissioned NTEX to upgrade its waste water treatment facility in response to the NT EPA's directive to take measures to resolve ongoing environmental issues.

Ancillary works for waste water treatment facility included:

- Cut & fill of 70,000m³ to facilitate construction of 6m high dam walls
- Storm water, plumbing and concrete infrastructure

Project Overview: Reinstatement of Marine Supply Base's Temporary Stock Pile Areas to the Ichthys Shore Approach Gas Pipe Line. Boskalis were appointed as the contractor responsible for the installation of the gas pipe line associated with the transportation of Gas from source to shore. Their scope of works included placing filter rock on top of the installed pipe followed by Armour rock to protect against marine vessels. As their remit was been completed, NTEX were engaged to re-instate the MSB's Temporary Stock Pile Area (where the rock was temporary stockpiled prior to being transported to the MSB on the wharf). Upon completion, the temporary stock pile area was handed back to the NT Government & ASCO.

- Major Dewatering due to wet season
- Importation of General Fill to site
- Cut & fill to level, grade & compact
- Removal of excess Filter rock & Armour rock offsite
- Removal of concrete Bollards offsite
- Placing of bitumen chip-seal around drainage pits
- Rehabilitation of surface water drainage culverts and open drainage pits to accommodate new site contours
